The following questions can be used for Small Group discussions or for personal reflection:

- 1. What is baptism? What does the word literally mean?
- 2. Why is it important that we be baptized?
- 3. In this message, we listed some of the benefits of baptism, the first being the forgiveness of sins. Why is this so essential?
- 4. The next benefit we discussed was the gift of the Holy Spirit. How have you experienced the presence of the Holy Spirit in your life?
- 5. Next, we saw the connection of Christ's death, burial, and resurrection to our own. Read Colossians 2:12, and Romans 6:3-5, and contemplate the connection and symbolism between the two.
- 6. Fourth, we saw how, at baptism, we are clothed with Christ (Galatians 3:27). Why is this so important?
- 7. Finally, we saw how baptism can connect us to the body of Christ, the Church. How does this help us in our spiritual growth?
- 8. Have you been baptized? If so, reflect on the meaning and importance of that event in your life. If not, what's preventing you from taking this step now?
- 9. For further study, read the following Scriptures (used in today's message): Acts 2:37-38; Matthew 28:18-20; Acts 8:26-40; John 3:23; 1 Corinthians 10:1-2; 1 Peter 3:20-22; Acts 22:16; Ephesians 1:13; Colossians 2:12; Romans 6:3-5; Galatians 3:27; 2 Corinthians 5:17; Acts 2:41; Romans 8:9.
