The following questions can be used for Small Group discussions or for personal reflection:

- 1. Review what you know about the story of David and Bathsheba. Now take the time to read through 2 Samuel 11 and 12. Did anything new stand out to you?
- 2. Have you ever experienced trying to hide a sin from others? What happened?
- 3. How was David's sin revealed? What was the relationship between David and Nathan?
- 4. David didn't deny or excuse his sin. Are there any areas of your life that you are denying or making excuses for?
- 5. David understood whom he had sinned against. Who is feeling the effects of your sin?
- 6. David realized that his sin had to be paid for by someone, and that it was a debt that he could not pay. Do you need reminded of this truth in any areas of your life? Be specific, at least to yourself, if not to others you trust.
- 7. Take some time right now and seek out any sin that you need to root out and eliminate from your life. Spend some time in prayer, asking God to remove it from your life.
- 8. For further study, read and discuss the following Scriptures: James 5:16; 1 John 1:9; Proverbs 28:13; Psalm 32:5; Psalm 51.
