The following questions can be used for Small Group discussions or for personal reflection:

1. What is the most important thing you can know?
2. Read through Colossians 1:15-23. What stands out to you about Jesus the most from this passage?
3. Review the ten things Paul lists about Jesus. Which one can you relate to the easiest?
4. Which one challenges you the most?
5. Which one do you need to meditate on, or learn about?
6. What does this passage say about us? How does that make you feel?
7. In spite of how bad we are, what's the good news that Paul offers the Colossians -- and us-- that is found only in Jesus?
8. Now reanswer the first question: What is the most important thing you can know? Has your answer changed?
9. For further study, read and discuss the following Scriptures (used in today's message): Colossians 1:15-23; John 4:24, 1:18, 14:9; Hebrews 1:3; Romans 6:8-9, 11; John 14:6.
