#### Matters for Reflection and Discussion:

- 1. Define the terms "supremacy" and "sufficiency." How do these terms fit into Paul's letter to the Colossians? How do they fit into your own life and faith?
- 2. Have you ever experienced a season of spiritual dryness or powerlessness? How did you feel? What helped in those seasons?
- 3. Describe a time in your life when someone came alongside you and offered encouragement that you desperately needed. How did that impact you?
- 4. What plausible arguments can you identify in our culture today? List as many as you can think of.
- 5. How do you guard yourself against the plausible arguments of the world and our culture?
- 6. How are we to walk in Christ? What does that look like? How do the terms "rooted," "built up," and "established" fit into this idea? How is this characteristic an indicator of the condition of your heart?
- 7. What are you grateful for in your life? Do you find it easy or difficult to be thankful? To express your thankfulness?
- 8. What is discernment? Do you have this ability? How can you strengthen it?
- 9. For further study, read and discuss the following Scriptures: Colossians 2:1-15, 3:2, 3:16; Romans 8:29; 1 Corinthians 2:16; Philippians 2:2.
