Matters for Reflection and Discussion:

- 1. Do you have an album of family pictures, or a hallway full of photos? What are some of the most significant photos to you? Why are they so important?
- 2. Read Ephesians 2:1-3, and 11-12. How does this passage make you feel? Now read verses 4-10 and 13. Describe the hope that is offered by these words.
- 3. What do you feel is your greatest need? How does that align with what the Bible says is our greatest need: The need to be saved from our sins?
- 4. Think about this statement: We can't *make* people be righteous or moral. We have to help them see the love of God in Jesus so that they *want* to be righteous and moral. Do you agree or disagree? Why?
- 5. Our greatest opportunity is to share the message of God's love with a world that needs to hear it. What do you think is the best way to do this? There may be various answers to this question.
- 6. Who do you know that needs to hear this message of hope? What are you going to do about it?
