Matters for Reflection and Discussion:

1. Describe what comes to mind when you think of the Incarnation.
2. What does the Incarnation reveal about God's love for us?
3. What does the Incarnation reveal about how God communicates to us? What is he saying?
4. How does the message of Jesus embody God's plan for humanity (Hebrews 1:3-4)?
5. How does the Incarnation ensure that Jesus could fully share in our humanity to accomplish His mission?
6. In what ways does Hebrews 2:17-18 describe Jesus as a faithful and merciful high priest? What do you think this means?
7. How does Jesus' suffering and temptation equip Him to offer mercy to us when we are tempted?
8. How can understanding the Incarnation deepen your trust in Jesus' mercy and faithfulness?
9. Consider this statement from C. S. Lewis: "The Son of God became a man to enable men to become sons of God." How does this impact your understanding of why Jesus came to us?
