#### Matters for Reflection and Discussion:

- 1. Read through the genealogy in Matthew 1. How does this emphasize the human lineage of Jesus? What does this tell us about his connection to mankind?
- 2. What is the significance of including key figures like Abraham, David, and others in Jesus' genealogy? How do these individuals highlight the humanity of Jesus?
- 3. How does the genealogy affirm Jesus' Jewish heritage? Why is this important for understanding his role as the Messiah?
- 4. Why is the title "Son of David" significant in Matthew's presentation of Jesus' genealogy? How does this title affirm both Jesus' human and Messianic nature?
- 5. What is the significance of the virgin birth in affirming the divine nature of Jesus? How does this miracle set him apart from all others in human history?
- 6. In Matthew 1:18, it says that Jesus was conceived by the Holy Spirit. What does this reveal about his divine origin and his identity as both fully God and fully man?
- 7. Read Isaiah 7:14. How does Matthew's reference to this passage affirm Jesus' divine nature? What does "Immanuel" (God with us) reveal about who Jesus is?
- 8. How does the angel's message to Joseph demonstrate God's direct involvement in bringing about the incarnation? What does this teach about the divine purpose behind Jesus' birth?
- 9. The angel tells Joseph to name the child "Jesus" because he will save his people from their sins. How does this name reflect his divine mission and authority?
