#### Matters for Reflection and Discussion:

- 1. What does it mean to live a life of holiness or sanctification? How is this different from simply following rules?
- 2. Why do you think Paul emphasizes that we should "excel more and more" in our walk with God? What might that look like practically in your life today?
- 3. How does understanding that sanctification is God's will for us shape your motivation to pursue holiness?
- 4. In what ways can obedience be seen as a natural response to genuine conversion? Can someone claim to follow Christ without pursuing holiness? Why or why not?
- 5. Paul warns that rejecting the call to holiness is ultimately rejecting God. How does this warning challenge or encourage you?
- 6. What are some specific areas in your daily life where you feel God is calling you to grow in holiness?
- 7. What role does the Holy Spirit play in helping us live holy lives? How can we be more aware of and responsive to His quidance?
- 8. Looking back over the past year, where have you seen growth in your pursuit of holiness? What specific steps can you take this week to continue excelling more and more?
